We would like to suggest: - At a minimum: the green space next to the building be moved to along the chain link fence to keep in place the mature trees which include: shag bark hickory, spruce, oak, cedar, and pine trees - Alternatively: the service loading paved area be reduced so that it ends at the northeast corner of the Mechanical/Electrical room. - The best case scenario: the service loading area end at the northwest corner of the Mechanical/Electrical room. Ideally, we would like the green space to be larger to accommodate the younger trees (spruce, fir, and pine) and maintain some privacy for our property. We would suggest keeping the chain link fence along the Walker Drain in place for safety, security, and our privacy.	We are impressed with the design and find it quite attractive. We live at [REDACTED personal information]. We, therefore, have a vested interest in the current green space next to the chain link fence. We have additional comments: For the parking lot, dark-sky friendly lighting that is truly dark-sky friendly in that the lights shine downward rather than out or upward. If the bulbs can be seen from a distance, it doesn't seem to be dark-sky friendly as the light shines in one's eyes. As for lighting on the building itself, Grand Bend's LCBO provides a great example of attractive and lighting that is easy on the eyes. Consideration of tinted windows on the north facing windows, especially on the second floor in hallway, #4. Warm up/Aerobic area would be appreciated. This would shield our property from the hallway lighting. In the Service/Loading area, it appears the doors are glass. We would prefer solid doors to reduce light and sound pollution.
