THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LAMBTON SHORES

BY-LAW NUMBER 46 of 2021

BEING A BY-LAW TO LIMIT THE TYPES OF SIGNS PERMITTED FOR A PERIOD OF 18 MONTHS

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 11(3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides the authority to a lower-tier municipality to pass by-laws relating to matters within the spheres of jurisdiction including, but not limited to, structures, including fences and signs;

AND WHEREAS the former Village of Grand Bend enacted By-Law 4084 of 2000 on June 5, 2000 to regulate signs;

AND WHEREAS the former Town of Forest enacted By-Law 22-1991 on September 16, 1991 to regulate signs;

AND WHEREAS the former Township of Bosanquet enacted By-Law 46 of 2000 on September 18, 2000 to regulate signs;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to implement a temporary control to limit the types of signs permitted until such time as a sign needs assessment is completed;

THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Lambton Shores enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT the issuance of permits and approval of electronic and/or animated signs be restricted until December 31, 2022.
- 2. THAT any sign permits issued allows for limitations of light intensity and screen copy frequency to be put in place at the discretion of staff.
- 3. THAT this by-law comes into effect on the day of passing.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME, AND FINALLY PASSED this 15th day of June, 2021.
