

**THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LAMBTON SHORES**

**BY-LAW 93 OF 2021**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO DEDICATE AND NAME LAND IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF  
LAMBTON SHORES AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY (WOODSIDE PHASE 3)**

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Lambton Shores acquired certain lands in the Municipality of Lambton Shores and deems it expedient to dedicate these lands as a public highway;

**THEREFORE**, the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Lambton Shores enacts as follows:

1. Block 29, Plan 25M-79, having been acquired by the Corporation of the Municipality of Lambton Shores, is hereby dedicated as a public highway and shall form part of and is hereby named HENNESSY STREET.
2. Block 30, Plan 25M-79, having been acquired by the Corporation of the Municipality of Lambton Shores, is hereby dedicated as a public highway and shall form part of and is hereby named PHIBBS STREET.
3. This By-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed.

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### Explanatory Note

Blocks 29 and 30 in Plan 25M-79 (Phase 3 of subdivision file SD-2006-04 - Wellington Brothers) were conveyed to the Municipality upon registration of the Plan. Their purpose was to give the Municipality control over access to Phase 4 of the development until a subdivision agreement was in place and the plan was registered. Now that Phase 4 has been registered and the works required under the agreement commenced with securities in place for their completion, there is no need for the Phase 3 reserves and they can be incorporated into the road allowances. This by-law dedicates Block 29 as part of the public highway known as Hennessy Street and Block 30 as part of the public highway known as Phibbs Street.
