In Summer of 2018, HASAR formed a 'Steering Committee'. This was created through volunteers as a committee to set the path to form a Search and Rescue Organization.

There is no 'formula' for creating a Search and Rescue, just several basic points provided by the Ontario Search and Rescue Volunteer Association (OSARVA).

Membership in OSARVA is required for all Ontario SAR's as it bring Provincial oversight and training as well as a Memorandum of Understanding with the Ontario Provincial Police. Membership is after 1 year minimum.
