RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Report CL 04-2024 titled “Warwick Fire Services Agreement Amendment” be received; and

THAT By-Law 13 of 2024 be approved.

SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with information on a request by the Township of Warwick to amend the current Fire Services Agreement.

BACKGROUND

The municipality entered into an updated agreement with the Township of Warwick for provision of fire services effective January 1, 2023. The current automatic aid agreement is for 63 households on Townsend Line, Birnam Line and Brickyard Line all in the Township of Warwick. Warwick has requested that an additional 14 households on Townsend Line be included in the agreement (map attached).

Staff have discussed the request with the Township of Warwick Fire Chief and CAO and all are satisfied with the proposal. There will be no additional changes to the agreement.

ALTERNATIVES TO CONSIDER

No alternatives are being presented.

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

Staff recommend the agreement with Township of Warwick for fire protection services be amended.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Under the agreement, Warwick pays Lambton Shores \$ 122.62 per household. The per household amount will be billed on the additional 14 households.
