

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LAMBTON SHORES

BY-LAW NUMBER 18 OF 2024

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 86 OF 2023
FEES AND CHARGES BY-LAW**

WHEREAS the Municipality of Lambton Shores passed By-Law 86 of 2023 on the 19th day of December 2023 being a by-law to establish various fees and charges for services provided by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to make amendments to By-Law 86 of 2023 and supporting Schedules;

THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Lambton Shores enacts as follows:

1. THAT Schedule C – Fire Services be amended as follows:

Fire Watch/Emergency Scene Security/Standby

4.2 Emergency scene security (included 2 fire fighters
and equipment) \$ 559.86/vehicle

Emergency Response – Public Roadway Call Outs (non-resident)

5.1 First hour \$ 559.86/vehicle

5.2 Every ½ hour thereafter \$ 279.93/vehicle

Emergency Response – False Alarm (3rd or more within 12 month period)

6.1 First hour \$ 559.86/vehicle

6.2 Every ½ hour thereafter \$ 279.93/vehicle

Emergency Response – Open Burn By-Law Violation

7.1 First hour \$ 559.86/vehicle

7.2 Every ½ hour thereafter \$ 279.93/vehicle

**Emergency Response – Nuisance/Malicious Technical Rescue (non-resident),
HAZMAT, Spills, Wildland Fire, Public Hazard Assistance Services**

8.1 First hour \$ 559.86/vehicle

8.2 Every ½ hour thereafter \$ 279.93/vehicle

Emergency Response – Utility Incidents – Natural Gas, Electrical

9.1 First Hour \$ 559.86/vehicle

9.2 Every ½ hour thereafter \$ 279.93/vehicle

6. THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME, AND FINALLY PASSED this 27th day of February, 2024.
